Talk It Over

Message Summary

Revelation urges us to live with urgency, reminding us that Jesus' return could happen anytime. The rapture's timing—before, during, or after tribulation—sparks debate, but the essential truth remains: Jesus is coming again. Our focus is to be prepared, faithful, and confident in our salvation, shining His light in a dark world.

Key Scriptures

Revelation 1:3

Blessed is the one who reads the words of this prophecy, and blessed are those who hear it and take to heart what is written in it, because the time is near.

1 Thessalonians 4:16-17

For the Lord himself will come down from heaven, with a loud command, with the voice of the archangel and with the trumpet call of God, and the dead in Christ will rise first. 17 After that, we who are still alive and are left will be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air. And so we will be with the Lord forever.

Revelation 3:10

Since you have kept my command to endure patiently, I will also keep you from the hour of trial that is going to come on the whole world to test the inhabitants of the earth.

Start Sharing (10-15 Minutes)

Choose a question(s) to create openness.

- When have you felt a sense of urgency in your faith, and what prompted it?
- What does being "prepared" for Jesus' return look like in your everyday life?
- What one action will you take this week to live more faithfully, in response to the truth of Revelation and the promise of Jesus' return?

Start Praying (10-15 Minutes)

Coach Says: *Revelation reminds us that readiness isn't passive.*

Pray Quietly:

- **Praise:** Begin by praising Jesus for His worthiness and what He has done for you.
- **Repent:** Silently ask God to reveal any distractions or sins keeping you from His mission.

Pray Together Out Loud:

- **Ask:** Pray together for open hearts and boldness to share Jesus in your city and state.
- **Yield:** Surrender your plans to God, asking Him to guide your group in fulfilling His purpose.

Start Doing

Start living with a sense of urgency, trusting Jesus with every circumstance, and sharing His hope with others. Let today be the day you step boldly into faith and shine His light in your community.
