- If a visitor asked you, "How can I volunteer at CCV?" what would you tell them? [Coach: this is a test to see if they know how to use the app to find areas of service for themselves to engage in.]
- Share with the group what you get out of serving at CCV.
- Have you taken the Spiritual Gifts test provided on the CCV website?

Scriptures:

- Romans 12:4-5, "For just as we have many members in one body and all the members do not have the same function, so we, who are many, are one body in Christ, and individually members one of another."
- Colossians 1:24, "Now I rejoice in my sufferings for your sake, and in my flesh, I do my share on behalf of His body, which is the church, in filling up what is lacking in Christ's afflictions."
- Colossians 1:18, "He is also head of the body, the church; and He is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead, so that He Himself will come to have first place in everything."
- **Ephesians 1:22,** "And He put all things in subjection under His feet, and gave Him as head over all things to the church."
- **Ephesians 5:23,** "For the husband is the head of the wife, as Christ also is the head of the church, He Himself being the Savior of the body."
- **John 2:19-22,** "Jesus answered them, "Destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up." The Jews then said, "It took forty-six years to build this temple, and will You raise it up in three days?" But He was speaking of the temple of His body."
- Ephesians 2:19, "So, then you are no longer strangers and aliens, but you are
 fellow citizens with the saints, and are of God's household, having been built on
 the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Christ Jesus Himself being the
 corner stone, in whom the whole building, being fitted together, is growing into a
 holy temple in the Lord,"
- 1 Corinthians 12:13, "For by one Spirit, we were all baptized into one body, whether Jews or Greeks, whether slaves or free, and we were all made to drink of one Spirit."
- 1 Corinthians 12:14-17, "For the body does not consist of one member but of many. If the foot should say, 'Because I am not a hand, I do not belong to the

body,' that would not make it any less a part of the body. And if the ear should say, 'Because I am not an eye, I do not belong to the body,' that would not make it any less a part of the body. If the whole body were an eye, where would be the sense of hearing? If the whole body were an ear, where would be the sense of smell?"

• **Ephesians 3:6**, "This mystery is that the Gentiles are fellow heirs, members of the same body, and partakers of the promise in Christ Jesus through the gospel."
