#### OPENING QUESTION:

#### READ:

- [1 Corinthians 1:10-17](#)

#### DISCUSS:

- Who is someone that you admire because of how they live out their faith boldly? What do they do that makes them stand out?
- Can you share an experience where you lived your faith, and it made you more confident to represent Jesus more boldly in the future?
- What truths do you need to claim from the passages listed below?
- Is there an area that you feel you need to step up to live your faith more boldly? (Spouse, work, friend, kids, service, etc.) In other words, what commitments do you need to make?

#### PRAYER:

As the leader, read [Acts 4:23–31](#) over the group and pray over them. Pray that God would give them boldness to make and keep commitments to make Jesus famous.

#### SCRIPTURES:

**Colossians 3:15**, “And let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, to which indeed you were called in one body. And be thankful.”

**2 Timothy 1:7**, “for God gave us a spirit not of fear but of power and love and self-control.”

**2 Corinthians 9:3**, “But I am sending the brothers so that our boasting about you may not prove empty in this matter, so that you may be ready, as I said you would be.”

**Ephesians 3:12**, "...in whom we have boldness and access with confidence through our faith in him."

**1 John 4:4**, "But You belong to God, my dear children. You have already won a victory over these people, because the Spirit who lives in you is greater than the spirit who lives in the world."

**Colossians 3:15**, "And let the peace that comes from Christ rule in your hearts. For as members of one body you are called to live in peace. And always be thankful."

**2 Corinthians 3:17–18**, "For the Lord is the Spirit, and wherever the Spirit of the Lord is, there is freedom. So all of us who have had that veil removed can see and reflect the glory of the Lord. And the Lord—who is the Spirit—makes us more and more like him as we are changed into his glorious image."
