#### **OPENING QUESTION:**

If you could choose one person or couple, real or fictional, to give you advice about your marriage or a key relationship, who would it be and why?

## **Deeper Contemplation Guide**

#### **READ:**

Genesis 2:24

Matthew 6:33

Colossians 4:2

2 Timothy 2:12-13

### **Thought Starters:**

- 1. Think of a time when being purposeful in pursuing a meaningful relationship with someone made a significant difference in your life?
- 2. What does Matthew 6:33 teach us about the importance of prioritizing our relationship with God?
- 3. What are some practical ways we can we actively seek God first in our relationships, and how might this impact the health and strength of those relationships?
- 4. Pastor Dave mentioned that 'transformation happens when you do consistently what others do occasionally.' What specific action will you commit to doing more consistently this month to foster transformation in your marriage or a key relationship, whether it's with a friend, family member, child, or parent?

#### **CHALLENGE:**

Use the prayer provided below to pray every day this week for a key relationship in your life.

#### TAKE HOME QUESTIONS:

**Table Talk** (a question to ask your family or friends over a meal): What is one small change you can make in your daily routine to prioritize the important relationships in your life, and how do you think it might affect those relationships?

Water Cooler (a question to ask at work): What's one habit or routine you've found helpful in maintaining strong relationships, whether at work or in your personal life?
