Message Summary

Godly men reject apathy and own their choices. From Adam's passivity to Jesus taking our sin, real manhood means leading with love, burying blame, and taking responsibility at home, work, and church.

I am going where everyone on earth must someday go. Take courage and be a man. 1 Kings 2:2 (NLT)

Be watchful, stand firm in the faith, act like men, be strong.
