SCRIPTURES:

Old Testament:

- **Deuteronomy 6:4–9**, “Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God, the LORD is one. ⁵ Love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength. ⁶ These commandments that I give you today are to be on your hearts. ⁷ Impress them on your children. Talk about them when you sit at home and when

you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up. ⁸ Tie them as symbols on your hands and bind them on your foreheads. ⁹ Write them on the doorframes of your houses and on your gates.”

- **Deuteronomy 8:3**, “Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that comes from the mouth of God.”
- **Joshua 1:8**, “This Book of the Law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate on it day and night, so that you may be careful to do according to all that is written in it. For then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have good success.”
- **Psalms 19:7–11**, “The law of the Lord is perfect, reviving the soul; the testimony of the Lord is sure, making wise the simple; the precepts of the Lord are right, rejoicing the heart; the commandment of the Lord is pure, enlightening the eyes; the fear of the Lord is clean, enduring forever; the rules of the Lord are true, and righteous altogether. More to be desired are they than gold, even much fine gold; sweeter also than honey and drippings of the honeycomb. Moreover, by them is your servant warned; in keeping them there is great reward.”
- **Psalms 119:9**, “How can a young man keep his way pure? By guarding it according to your word.”
- **Psalms 119:105**, “Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path.”
- **Isaiah 40:8**, “The grass withers, the flower fades, but the word of our God will stand forever.”
- **Isaiah 55:11**, “So shall my word be that goes out from my mouth; it shall not return to me empty, but it shall accomplish that which I purpose, and shall succeed in the thing for which I sent it.”

New Testament

- **Matthew 24:35**, “Heaven and earth will pass away, but my words will not pass away.”
- **Romans 10:17**, “So faith comes from hearing, and hearing through the word of Christ.”
- **Romans 15:4**, “For whatever was written in former days was written for our instruction, that through endurance and through the encouragement of the Scriptures we might have hope.”
- **2 Timothy 3:16**, “All Scripture is breathed out by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness.”
- **Hebrews 4:12–14**, “For the word of God is living and active, sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing to the division of soul and of spirit, of joints and of marrow, and discerning the thoughts and intentions of the heart. And no creature is hidden from his sight, but all are naked and exposed to the eyes of him to whom we must

give account. Since then we have a great high priest who has passed through the heavens, Jesus, the Son of God, let us hold fast our confession.”
