WHAT TO BRING to Rocky Point:

DO NOT BRING: Weapons or illegal drugs of any kind.

VERY Important:

- Family Trip: Passport (16yo+) or Birth Certificate Copy (minors under 16 only who are with a parent)
- High School Trip: Passport (19yo+) or Birth Certificate (students aged 18 and under)
- Prescribed medication for the trip duration (including asthma inhalers and allergy medication if needed)
- Public Health Supplies Face Mask(s), Hand Sanitizer, Sanitizing Wipes for your personal use.

General Important Items

- Something to sleep in Tent or confirmed R.V. reservation or confirmed bunkhouse reservation
- Toiletries: soap, shampoo, deodorant, towel, etc.
- Sandals (shower)
- Flashlight
- Camp Chair
- Sturdy refillable water bottle
- Sunscreen and Hat
- Camera
- Tools (Optional): Basic handsaw, hammer, utility knife, tape measure, nail pouch.
- Money for the 1Mission gift shop, 1Mission tshirts and accessories as well as local made items to support the ministry.

Clothes

- Base camp casual clothes (Shorts OK)
- Optional Swim Suit for showers and pool
- Appropriate Work clothes (NO dresses, shorts, Capri's, or tank tops)
- Work Shoes/boots No open toes on worksites
- Work Gloves leather or canvas
- Warm Clothes Evenings & Mornings get Cold
- Rain gear. If it rains, it will be COLD.

If you're in a tent or in the bunkhouse:

- Sleeping bag, blanket, and pillow, foam/air mattress
- A rug or mat and camp chairs to put outside.
- Shoes to walk to and from the shower house/bathroom with
- Good blankets and something to sleep on more than just the sleeping bag.
- Extension cord if you have an electric pump for your air mattress

Extras that are optional: Bring in small quantities; do not overwhelm them or create a daily expectation of what you have.

- NO CASH is to be given to anyone.
- **To play with the kiddos** and have fun at the work site: Nail polish, face paint, toy cars, soccer balls (expect to leave it there), candy, coloring books/crayons, craft stuff. Candy.
- **Donations for the family:** Small housewarming, personal gifts are appropriate. Please no large bags of clothes or old thing. Also note, it's never appropriate to hand anyone you meet any cash.

Extras that are optional for your convenience:

• Cases of bottled water for you and your family, Snacks/Breakfast type foods for your own consumption, Pop Up tents for the work site.
