Club Fee

The Club Fee is the operational cost per club player for participation for the season. This fee is paid when a player is offered a roster spot and secures their spot on the team. The Club Fee pays for, but is not limited to professional coaching and training, field usage and maintenance, insurance, administration and operational support and fees, and any other programs offered by the club. All Club Fees will be paid through our club management app PlayMetrics. Payment plans are available with a minimum payment of \$300 due at time of registration.

Team Fee

The Team Fee varies per age group, level of team, and it covers team specific costs such as league fees, referee fees, tournament registrations, coach travel expenses, team equipment, and other team related expenses. Specific Team Fee amounts are usually available from your coach or team manager in May/June. These payments will be paid in our club management app PlayMetrics.

Uniform Costs

Uniform ordering is completed and paid for individually through our online portal with TeamHUB Sports. Ordering should not be completed until a player's roster is assigned by the club coach and the registration fee has been

paid. The 2024-2025 season is the first year of a two-year uniform cycle for the club. Player uniforms will be manufactured by Nike and our club representative will be Soccer Village.

Elite 64 Team/Player Options

- <u>Proscore</u> (team) This is the software that provides video analysis for teams and individual players. Team and player analysis will be included at no additional cost.
- <u>Soccer Profile</u> (player) This is a platform available for individual technical assessments and resources for the player. This will be included for the player for the first year.
- NCSA This is a platform to build a player profile with information to connect with college coaches. A
 free basic profile will be included. Additional options will be available for the player at a cost.
- <u>Veo</u> The camera will be included free or at a significant discount. The subscription will be discounted.
- <u>Statsports (per player)</u> This is the analysis software and training vests to track data related to performance and fitness. The cost for each unit is \$240. This is a one-time cost and the player will keep the unit and ability to use it for life. They can use it in any team they play on. If the player loses or breaks the equipment, it will be the responsibility of the player to replace the equipment

GOALS, POLICIES, AND EXPECTED BEHAVIOR

- Playing Up: You must dominate your age group and be an impact player at the next age group for it to be allowed. Director of Coaching must approve. All players must tryout at least one time in their natural age group and the older age group before it will be granted to play-up.
- Loaning Players to Clubs Outside Stars: We do not loan players to other clubs during the season.
- Playing Time: Coaches are expected to play the players they choose on their teams throughout the season. A percentage is not guaranteed.
- Be positive and encourage all players, coaches, and family members
- No gossip or negative talk about players, coaches, referees, or opponents
- No parent coaching from the sideline at practice or games and no parent interaction with the referee
- No parent interrupting practice or games
