Welcome to CCV Stars Surprise Club Soccer! We are honored that you have chosen to look further into our program. With the help and support of more than 1,700 volunteers, we have created a high quality, professionally run multi-sport youth program with more than 20,000 annual participants based on Christian principals.

CCV Stars is open to all players and families, regardless of race, religion, color, or creed. Many call CCV their home church but this is not a requirement to play. Our motto is **More Than A Game (MTAG)** and we regularly emphasize our “3 C’s”, **Character – Competition – Community**. Our players, coaches, and parents have high standards of sportsmanship and clear focus on code of conduct. We pray at practices and games and expect players to participate in a short character development program every week. We promote an open, safe, and friendly environment where everyone is welcome.

SEASON INFORMATION

U7-U10 Academy, Born 2013-2016

- 35-week season from mid-August through April
- Two practices per week
- Professional skills + speed/agility training
- Compete in Academy League with other top clubs
 - Approx. 10 play date weekends
 - 2015-2016: 4v4, developmental and balanced teams for games
 - 2013-2014: 7v7 w/ goalkeepers (training offered), teams grouped by ability

U11-U15, Born 2007-2012

- 35-week season from mid-August through April
- Three practices per week
- Professional skills & goalkeeping training + speed/agility training
- Compete in:
 - USYS Desert Conference League, ASA Arizona Premier League, ASA Arizona State League, ASA Open League and possibly USYS National League
 - Various local, regional, and national tournaments
 - ASA National (State) Cup or President’s Cup

PRICING & WHAT'S INCLUDED

U7-U10 Academy, Born 2013-2016

- \$230 annual registration
- \$145 uniform u7-u8 (game kit: one jersey, short, sock; practice kit: two each - shirts, shorts, socks, hoodie – **mandatory**. Can purchase warm-up pants, warm-up jacket, and bag for an additional \$87)
- \$210 uniform u9-u10 (game kit: two each - jerseys, shorts, socks; practice kit: three each - shirts, shorts, socks, hoodie – **mandatory**. Can purchase warm-up pants, warm-up jacket, and bag for additional \$72)
- \$55/month program fee; paid in advance every eight weeks
- Additional costs: tournament fees, travel, team expenses

U11-U14, Born 2009-2012

- \$260 annual registration
- \$210 uniform u9-u10 (game kit: two each - jerseys, shorts, socks; practice kit: three each - shirts, shorts, socks, hoodie – **mandatory**. Can purchase warm-up pants, warm-up jacket, and bag for additional \$72)
- \$70/month (approx.) program fee; paid in advance every eight weeks
- Additional costs: tournament fees, travel, team expenses

Uniform note – we use the same style of uniform for two full seasons. This season will be the start of a new two-year cycle so everyone will be required to purchase new uniforms.

TRYOUT PROCESS & TEAM SELECTION

All interested players must tryout (\$10 tryout fee) and be selected for a club soccer team as not all players will be selected. We anticipate three dates per age/gender for which all players are encouraged to participate. A detailed schedule for placements/tryouts can be found at the Stars website under Surprise Club Soccer. A player wishing to tryout in an older age group “must” tryout in his or her natural age group as well. See “playing-up” policy later in this guide. Professional coaches will be heavily involved in the age specific placements and tryouts to be able to group the players with “like level” qualities. In addition to soccer skill and athleticism, we are looking for players who have a high degree of character, loyalty, and a positive attitude.

- Born in 2013-2016: April 24 – May 4
- Born in 2007-2012: May 1 – May 11

PROGRAM GOALS

- Training for excellence and competing to do your best always

- Building Godly leaders to impact the valley through youth sports

CLUB POLICIES EXPECTED BEHAVIOR (SUMMARY)

Playing Up: You must dominate your age group and be an impact player at the next age group for it to be allowed. Program Director & Director of Coaching must approve. All players must tryout at least one time in their natural age group and the older age group before it will be granted to play-up. No exceptions.

Loaning Players to Clubs Outside Stars: We do not loan players to other clubs during the season. Players registered for CCV Stars Club Soccer should only play for their school or CCV Stars, no other clubs during season.

Playing Time: 50% or greater "on average" until final competition phase.

EXPECTED BEHAVIOR

In line with our More Than A Game philosophy, the following are our standards for behavior that detail our high expectations for character and sportsmanship. This includes clear consequences for coaches, players, and parents if rules are not followed.

- Be positive and encourage all players, coaches, and family members
- No gossip or negative talk about players, coaches, referees, or opponents
- No parent coaching from the sideline at practice or games
- No parent interrupting practice or games
- No foul language
- Show sportsmanship in all situations
- No parent interaction with the referee
- No use of illegal substances by our players or coaches at anytime
