Discuss:

- Read <u>1 Peter 3:1-7</u>. Why do you think this is such a difficult passage to apply for so many people? (For both men and women). [5 min]
- Read <u>1 Peter 3:8-12</u>. Have you ever repaid good for evil? What was the result? [5 min]
- Read <u>1 Peter 3:13-17</u>. Have you ever suffered for doing good? [5 min]

Scriptures:

- **Psalm 34 Intro** (NIV) "Of David. When he pretended to be insane before Abimelek, who drove him away, and he left."
- **Psalm 34:12-16** (NIV) "Whoever of you loves life and desires to see many good days, keep your tongue from evil and your lips from telling lies. Turn from evil and do good; seek peace and pursue it. The eyes of the Lord are on the righteous, and his ears are attentive to their cry; but the face of the Lord is against those who do evil, to blot out their name from the earth."
- Psalm 34:21-22 (NIV) "Evil will slay the wicked; the foes of the righteous will be condemned. The Lord will rescue his servants; no one who takes refuge in him will be condemned."
