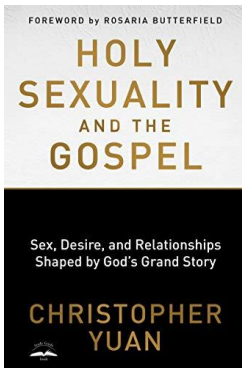


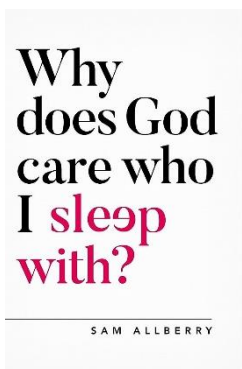

Why we like this book:

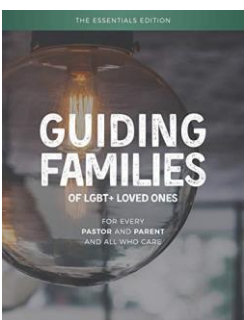
- Helps to better understand sexuality in light of God's grand story and realize that holy sexuality is actually good news for all.

- Shares the Bible's teaching on love, sex and marriage and is good read for people who may see it as a stumbling block for belief.

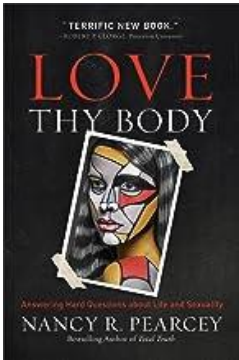


[Guiding Families of LGBT+ Loved Ones – Bill Henson](#)

- Filled with practical, ready-to-use relational tips; answers to common questions; and explorations of grief, parental influence, and relational care.

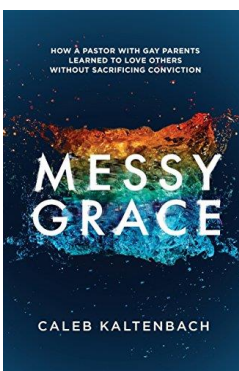

- Offers reality-oriented solutions that embrace the dignity of the human body and provide a sustainable basis for inalienable human rights.

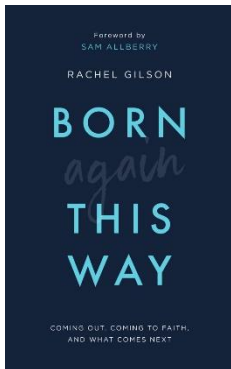


[Messy Grace: How a Pastor with Gay Parents Learned to Love Others Without Sacrificing Conviction – Caleb Kaltenbach](#)
