U7-U10 Academy, Born 2018-2015

- Season is from August through April
- Two training sessions per week, with optional 3rd training session focusing on technique
- Compete in:
 - ASA Academy League
 - Various local tournaments
- Access to technical training app - Techne
- GK training offered once per week (U9-U10)

U11-U19 Club, Born 2014-2006

- Season is from August through April
- Three training sessions per week
- Compete in:
 - ASA Arizona Premier League, ASA Arizona State League, and/or ASA Open League
 - USYS Elite 64 (U13-U19)
 - Various local, regional, and national tournaments
 - ASA State Cup or President’s Cup
- Access to technical training app – Techne (U11 and U12 teams)
- GK training offered
- SAQ (Strength, Agility, Quickness) Training Offered (U13-U19)

Club Fee

The Club Fee is the operational cost per club player for participation for the season. This fee is paid when a player is offered a roster spot and secures their spot on the team. The Club Fee pays for, but is not limited to professional coaching and training, field usage and maintenance, insurance, administration and operational support and fees, and any other programs offered by the club. All Club Fees will be paid through our club management app Playmetrics. Payment plans are available with a minimum payment of \$300 due at time of registration.

Team Fee

The Team Fee varies per age group, level of team, and it covers team specific costs such as league fees, tournament registrations, coach travel expenses, team equipment, and other team related expenses. Specific Team Fee amounts are usually available from your coach or team manager in May/June. These payments will be paid in our club management app PlayMetrics.

Uniform Costs

Uniform ordering is completed and paid for individually through our online portal with TeamHUB Sports. Ordering should not be completed until a player's roster is assigned by the club coach and the registration fee has been paid. The 2024-2025 season is the first year of a two-year uniform cycle for the club. Player uniforms will be manufactured by Nike and our club representative will be Soccer Village.

U7/U8 – \$250-\$275 (includes 1 jersey set, 1 practice set, ¼ zip jacket, and backpack)

U9/U19 – \$330-\$360 (includes 2 jersey sets, 1 practice set, ¼ zip jacket, and backpack)

GOALS, POLICIES, AND EXPECTED BEHAVIOR

- To live by our values of Character, Community, and Competition
- Establishing “ambassador” teams to represent CCV and Stars in the community
- Playing Up: You must dominate your age group and be an impact player at the next age group for it to be allowed. Director of Coaching must approve. All players must tryout at least one time in their natural age group and the older age group before it will be granted to play-up.
- Loaning Players to Clubs Outside Stars: We do not loan players to other clubs during the season.
- Playing Time: Coaches are expected to play the players they choose on their teams throughout the season. A percentage is not guaranteed.
- Be positive and encourage all players, coaches, and family members
- No gossip or negative talk about players, coaches, referees, or opponents
- No parent coaching from the sideline at practice or games and no parent interaction with the referee
- No parent interrupting practice or games
