



## AIR TICKETS

### 1. GROUP AIR TICKETS: \$2995 + \$1200 = \$4195

• If you're flying with the group, your transfers to and from airport will be included. There are no upgrades or seat selections when traveling with group air. You will have to purchase your air outside the group.

## 2. INDIVIDUAL AIR TICKETS: \$2995 + your flight cost = your final price

- If you are buying your own air tickets, you will be responsible for your own transfers (getting to the hotel on the first day and getting back to the airport on the last day). You must arrange travel to arrive at Herod's Hotel in Herzliya on the evening of Thursday, May 20. You must arrange travel to depart from Grand Court Hotel, Jerusalem anytime after dinner, Saturday, May 29.
- You Must decide whether you're opting in or out of our group air tickets by 2/1.

### PACKING SUGGESTIONS

### • In your Carry-On:

- Passport, Money, Electronics
   Medications in their original packaging.
- A change of clothing in case the unexpected happens and your bags are lost.
- Light Jacket

### In your Checked Suitcase:

- Comfortable casual clothes. No dress up clothes will be needed.
- Comfortable, sturdy shoes that you can walk in all day. (2 to 3 miles per day) You should try to switch your shoes and not wear the same pair each day.
- Hair dryers included in hotel rooms.
- Swimsuit or trunks for the Dead Sea or your hotel.

#### **NOTE:** Ladies –

- You should pack a large scarf that you can wrap on your shoulders or if you should need to cover your head.
- Include tops that cover your shoulders. There is one visit where all women will be required to wear pants down
- to the ankle. You will be advised about this the prior evening.

## WEATHER IN ISRAEL IN MAY

Jerusalem, 60 to 78 degrees

Tiberias: 65 to 89 degrees

Dead Sea: 74 to 91 degrees

It is very warm in the direct sunshine, dress accordingly.

Layering is suggested as it will be cooler in the mornings and warmer in the afternoon.

American dollar is accepted. Carry small bills -\$1; \$5; \$10. No need to convert dollars to **MONEY:** New Shekels. If you need shekels you can get at the hotels in country. The Israel people love the US dollar.



### **CREDIT CARDS:**

Are accepted everywhere we will be going. Be sure to contact your bank and let them know where you will be traveling. Visa and Master card are most accepted.



### **CELL PHONES:**

Please check with your carrier before leaving regarding the cost of data & text while you are in Israel.

# Water Hotel Beds Bus

### • WATER:

- Although the water in Israel is safe, it is recommended you do not drink water from the hotel faucets and drinking fountains. OK to brush teeth and shower but do not drink.
- The water that is served at all meals is safe to drink. There will be bottled water provided on the buses for drinking during the day. Please drink lots of water.

### HOTEL BED CONFIGURATION:

• King beds for married couples, 2 queen beds for all others.

### • RESTROOMS ON BUS:

• There are no restrooms on the buses. We will not travel more than 1 to 1 ½ hours without a restroom break.

### BUS SEATING:

 Seats are not assigned for the buses. Whatever bus you get on the first day will be your bus for the whole tour. We will have 3 buses—A, B, C. You do not have to sit in the same seats each day on your bus, but you will stay on the same bus.

### Can I get baptized in the Jordan River?

• Yes, we will have a baptismal service at the Jordan River. Baptisms are only allowed while wearing the special white robes, which can be rented or purchased on site. Swim-suits must be worn under the robe.

**SHOPPING:** There will be allotted time for shopping while on tour.



TOUR TIMES: Daily Tour start times will vary depending on our schedule. We will shoot for 8.



**LUGGAGE:** 

1 suitcase at 50lbs, 1 carry on plus purse or backpack per person.



LAUNDRY:

Each hotel will have laundry service at additional cost. No self-service laundry available.



SHOTS/VACCINATIONS:

None required for entry to Israel or entry back to USA, but suggest you check with your family physician.



**LISTENING DEVICES:** 

Headsets will be provided for easy listening of the guides at each tour stop.



TIPPING:

All tips are included for everything except your lunch meal. It is suggested \$1 P/P is adequate for that tip.
